Candidates should stay up-to-date on management and leadership principles, labor market functioning, local economic and social conditions, local educational and social service organizations, local population groups and community organizations, and relevant government rules and regulations. They should also maintain a thorough knowledge of WIOA, TANF, SNAP, CCMS, Adult Education, and ESL, as well as U.S. Department of Labor and other federal grant requirements and Texas Workforce Commission laws, regulations, directives, and policy papers.
